THE COMMIT PROJECT

"Engaging diaspora and migrant COMMunities in the protection of the righTts of the child" (2021-2023) is a transnational project involving organizations from four European countries (Cyprus, Greece, Italy, France), aiming at stimulating the **engagement of migrant communities and diasporas in Europe in the promotion and protection of the Rights of the Child**. It strives to do so through mobilizing community leaders, families and children to create a safe community environment of child development and wellbeing.

THE E-LEARNING PLATFORM

Migrant communities are important actors to improve child protection systems. However, their role in the promotion of children's rights is underestimated. The aim of the **COMMIT e-learning course**, addressed to members of diaspora associations and migrant individuals, is to promote awareness and knowledge of children's rights within migrant communities and diasporas in Europe.



THE PROJECT RESULTS

The project followed three main lines of action:

- Strengthen the skills and knowledge on children's rights of members of diaspora organizations, migrant individuals, and professionals through the **implementation of a 20-hour training in 4 countries;**
- Engage migrant communities by building their capacity and raising awareness of children's rights and child protection systems through the **implementation of Children's Diaspora Laboratories in 4 countries;**
- Further promote the **role of migrant communities** in protecting and promoting children's rights by actively involving them in **capacity-building, education and active citizenship activities.**
