## BACKGROUND

The Ministry of Health and Social Protection coordinates all activities for the inclusiveness and equality of the Roma and Egyptian minorities in Albania. The Launching Event of the 'Constructive Engagement Platform' marks a momentous occasion for Inclusive EduJobs—an initiative funded by the European Union dedicated to improving the employability and educational achievements of Roma and Egyptian communities in Albania. Led by the Open Society Foundation for Albania in collaboration with the Municipality of Tirana and the Social Action and Innovation Center (KMOP, Greece), this project addresses challenges faced by Roma and Egyptian minorities through participatory, context-relevant models in employment and inclusive education.

This activity is not only a cause for celebrating the platform's launch but also acts as a catalyst for ongoing cooperation. Aligned with the platform's vision, the activity will bring together various actors to address the challenges faced by the Roma and Egyptian minority in the country.

At the core of the project's goals is the construction of sustainable cooperation and constructive dialogue among decision-making actors. This collaborative approach aims to establish equal access to quality education and employment opportunities. Through the active engagement of the minorities themselves in the dialogue for designing and testing models, this initiative aims to mitigate inequality and create a favorable situation for the economic empowerment of the Roma and Egyptian communities.
