Specifically, PR3 aims to provide a training programme for: NGO volunteers, adult education staff and more generally people with a migration background. The aim is to help them develop useful skills to offer effective education on the topic of migration and to provide adequate support to **migrants** in their integration journey.

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COURSE STRUCTURE

The training program is free and open and consists of 5 modules:

- 1. Intercultural skills
- 2. Transversal skills for migrants
- 3. Establish a mentor-mentee relationship
- 4. Fight against racism, discrimination and xenophobia
- 5. Create a network

The courses are available in: Italian, English, French, German and Greek. To follow the courses you need to register on the platform \bigcirc
