At EU and National level, on the result of a desk (focus on the mapping of policies frameworks in partners countries) and field research (focus on 5 different coaching circles in each partners country)

Multidisciplinary Framework

To be developed at a European level for the creation of integrated and replicable social economy experiments relating to the EntreComp and GreenComp frameworks



Train the target groups

Train 14 young adults (18 - 30) with fewer opportunities and seniors (65+) from each project country (70 in total) who will then become promoters of such clusters at local level

Creation of guidelines

Develop policy recommendations and guidelines for local governments and policy makers on supporting the social economy through the creation, support and promotion of SEEDs

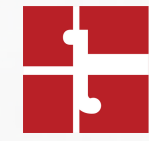
Support system
