Polish Academia NAUK, in cooperation with the PROGENDERING project's consortium organised online the **International Multiplier Event** "How Can Higher Education Become More Gender Equal?". The event brought together academics, experts, and students from across Europe to exchange experiences and strategies for promoting gender equality in higher education institutions.

A highlight of the workshop was the **presentation of small-scale student projects** developed by partner universities. These projects showcased practical initiatives aimed at fostering inclusion and equality within academic communities. The workshop offered a unique opportunity to learn from peers, discuss challenges and successes, and explore actionable ways to create more gender-responsive and inclusive universities.




Figure 1: Online International Multiplier Event, 04 November 2025
