KMOP Policy Center invites youth workers in Belgium to join the “**Youth for Inclusive Communities**” to deepen their skills in participatory design and empower young people to shape inclusive local communities.

The journey begins with an international Train-the-Trainers programme in Strasbourg, France (14–17 September) and continues over 12 months through training, mentoring and collaboration with partners across Europe.

WHY JOIN?

As a participant, you will:

expert training on participatory design, intersectionality and inclusive community planning.
- **DEVELOP**
the skills to train other youth professionals in Belgium.
- **MENTOR**
a group of young people as they design community projects, explore participatory decision-making and develop policy recommendations.

in international activities, including a youth exchange in Poland and the EU Advocacy Marathon in Brussels.
- **JOIN**
a European network of organisations working to strengthen youth participation and social inclusion.

All travel costs are covered, and participants will receive a YouthPass Certificate together with access to practical tools and learning resources throughout the programme.
